**ALL ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY ENTRY FEES AND MONEY.
MUST BE RECEIVED BY MONDAY (10th FEBRUARY)
OR THEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

The infusion of any substance into the mammary system to alter the outward appearance of the udder of milk veins.

The gluing or taping of the teats or the use of any artificial practices to affect the teat angle or teat placement.

The use of artificial hair for "false switch".

The use of any stomach pump or such device to inflate the stomach or udder unnaturally.

It will be an offence to administer any skin irritant or any like substance that alters the natural conformation or contour of the animals' body, in the way of swelling.

Judging will start at 9 am for cattle.

When an exhibit is not up to show standard, the awarding of a prize will be at the judge's discretion.

Decision of the judge is final.

Exhibits must be named as to kind or class.

Protests will be dealt with by a special committee.

All cattle to be haltered and led into the ring.

The Society reserves the right to substitute trophies of equal value for cash prizes.

No persons other than officials and competitors will be allowed inside the ring.

Stock must parade on show day or prize money may be forfeited.

The Committee will give every possible facility to exhibitors and every care will be taken of exhibits, but no responsibility will be incurred by the Society.

The Society will not be responsible for any accident that might be caused through or by an exhibit, this shall be a condition of entry onto the ground.

The Committee reserves the right to combine or delete classes if necessary.

Exhibitors wishing to insure animals in transit should make their own arrangements.
